TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Location	All games will be played in Philomath, Oregon at one of the following locations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• PHS (2054 Applegate Street)• PES (239 South 16th Street)• PMS (2021 Chapel Drive)• CPS (535 South 19th Street)
Format	Preference will be given to teams made up of members who will be attending a common 4A or lower high school (1A-4A). All teams are guaranteed to play 4 games.
Schedule	Game schedules will be e-mailed out the week of the tournament. In most cases teams will play 2 games Saturday and 2 games Sunday. However, games may be split 3 one day and 1 on the other. Gyms will open 30 minutes before the first game each morning.
Team Entry & Admission Fees	Team entry fee is \$190 per team (\$175 for early registration – if received by 1/8/2010). There will be a \$4 admission charge for adults (18 years and older) per day, which is good for all day. Kids (under 18 years) are admitted free.
Scorekeepers	Scorekeepers and score clock operators will be provided.
Awards	Awards will be given to the 1 st and 2 nd place teams at each grade level.
Concessions	Concessions will be sold on-site.
Refunds	No refunds will be given unless we are notified 7 days before the tournament.
Jerseys	All teams are required to have light <u>and</u> dark jerseys.

Registration is open until filled. <i>Deadline for early registration discount is 1/8/2010. Teams registering by 1/8/2010 will be entered into a drawing for a prize.</i>

GAME RULES

Game Time	Four 12-minute running-clock quarters. One 2-minute stop-clock overtime, if needed. Additional 2-minute running-clock overtime periods, if needed. If, at the 2 minute mark of the 4 th quarter, the score difference is less than 10 points, the clock shall revert to a stop-clock for the remainder of the game. If the score difference is 10 points or more at the 2 minute mark, a running clock will remain in effect. The clock situation at the 2 minute mark will remain in effect for the remainder of the game regardless of score changes.
Time Outs & Half-Time	Teams will receive 4 full (1 minute) time outs per game. Teams will receive one additional full time out for the first overtime period. Half time will be 5 minutes.
Defense	Teams may play either man-to-man, or zone defense. Teams are allowed to use full court press as long as the lead is less than 20 points. After a 20-point lead, teams may not employ any backcourt pressure.
Game Start Time	Teams will forfeit if not ready to play 10 minutes after scheduled game start time.
